A 16 passenger bus will take us to the dock in Kingsville where we walk on to the Jiiman ferry boat which returns to pick us up at 4 pm. for the trip home.

The bus can accommodate people with mobility limitations.

Early registration is essential.

At least one vehicle will go to the island with us for transportation on the island. Other private vehicles are welcome as well.

\$20 each will offset some of the full cost of transportation.
