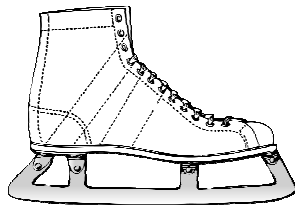
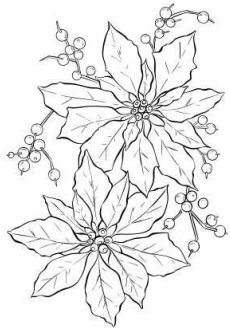


~ I Love First Peoples Shoebox Gifts ~
