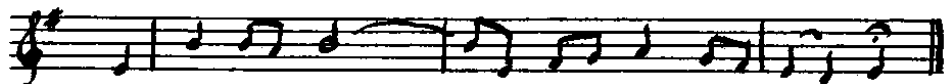

The Communion of the People

Music during Communion: 73 One Bread, One Body

All are welcome to come forward at Communion. All Baptised Christian are welcome to receive the Body and Blood of Christ in this Eucharistic Feast. Please know also that taking just one of the elements is receiving the fullness of the Eucharist. To receive a blessing from the priest simply cross your hands on your chest to indicate your desire.

A walk-up communion station is offered at the Chancel steps and a kneeling station at the Good Shepherd/Girl Guide Chapel. Please receive the Bread/Body of Christ in your hands. Please then drink directly from the common cup of the Wine/Blood of Christ (please no intinction or dipping of the Bread into the Wine).

If you wish to acknowledge but not partake of the wine, a common practice is to reverently touch the base of the Chalice when it is presented to you.

A gluten sensitive Bread/Body of Christ option is available at the Good Shepherd/Girl Guide Chapel. Please motion to the priest that you wish to receive this.
