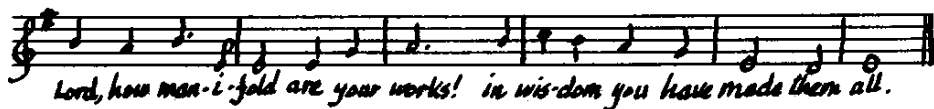

**All Holy, holy, holy Lord
God of power and might
Heaven and earth are full of your glory:

One God of all creation, send your Spirit upon the goodness of the earth, and upon these gifts of bread and wine, that in them we may recognize and receive the fullness of the Risen Christ: bread broken and wine poured, Body given and Blood shed.

On the night before he offered himself, Jesus recalled with his disciples the wonder of your creation and the covenant you made with your chosen people. It will be shed for you and for all so that sins may be forgiven. Do this in memory of me.'
