


Unusual exit of a prophet

Today's lessons:

- 2 Kings 2:1-12 At the end of his life, the prophet Elijah to whom God had appeared at Mount Horeb does not die like other people but is taken away to heaven while his disciple Elisha is watching.
- Psalm 50:1-6 God is Lord over all creation.
- 2 Corinthians 4:3-6 Jesus Christ is the light, but not everybody sees that light. We believe because our eyes have been opened by God.
- Mark 9:2-9 Jesus leads the three disciples who are closest to him on top of mountain where two of the most important people of the Old Testament appear to them: Moses and Elijah. It turns out that Jesus is even more important than them.
