1 Corinthians 10:1-13

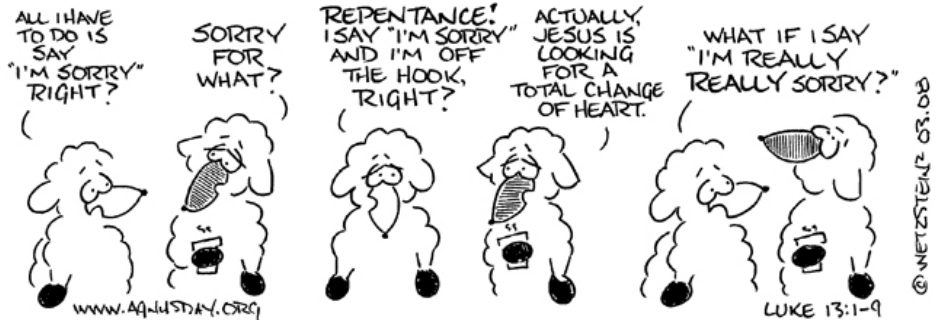
