Today's lessons:

- Haggai 1:15b-2:9 When the people are getting depressed comparing the newly rebuilt Temple with the glory of the old one, God reminds them that he is with them.
- Psalm 145:1-5, 17-21 God is good and does great things for all of his creation.
- 2 Thessalonians 2:1-5, 13-17 Be patient, waiting for the return of Jesus Christ; it may take time but you have the traditions and the communion of the Church.
- Luke 20:27-38 Jesus teaches some who don't believe in the resurrection that life after death is not just a continuation of life in this world.

 IF LUKEWARM.**

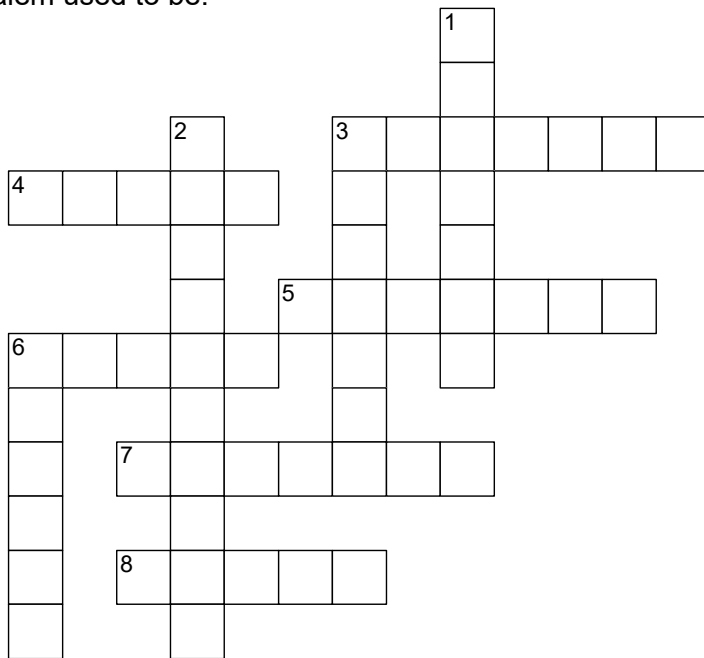

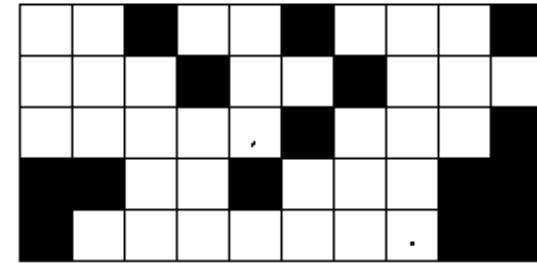
- 1 often made from stained glass
