- Luke 21:5-19 Jesus warns his followers against people who claim that the end of the world is near.

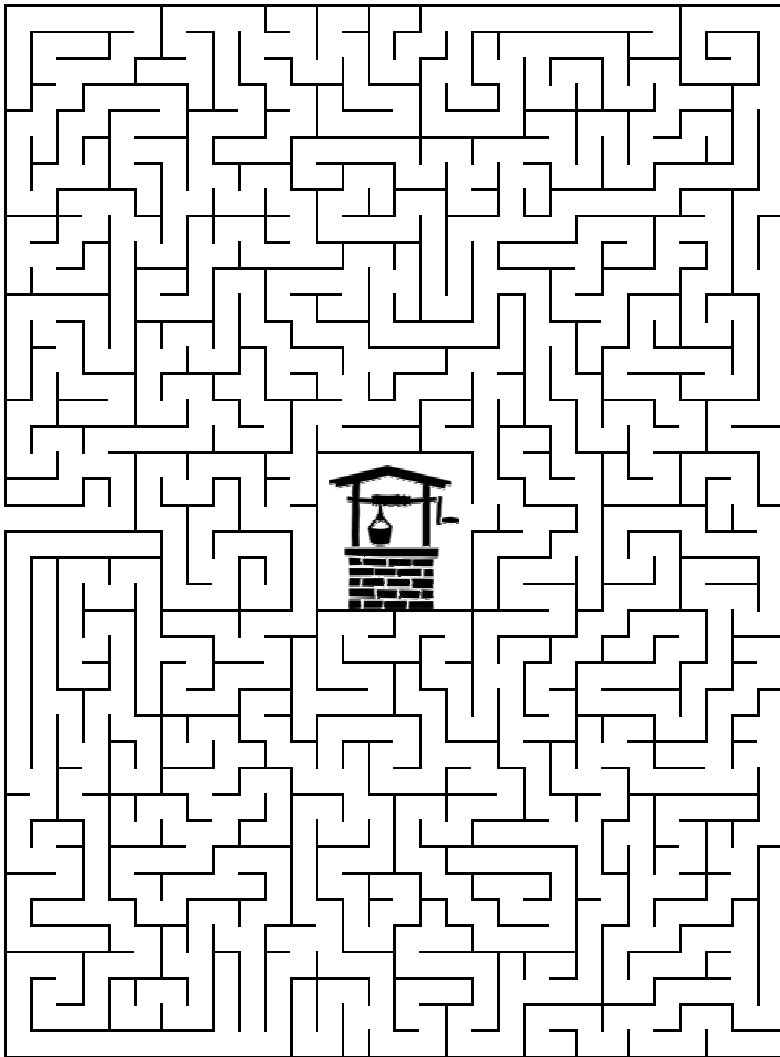

Now, Jesus certainly spoke about the end in today's gospel lesson, but did he really mention doing the dishes?!



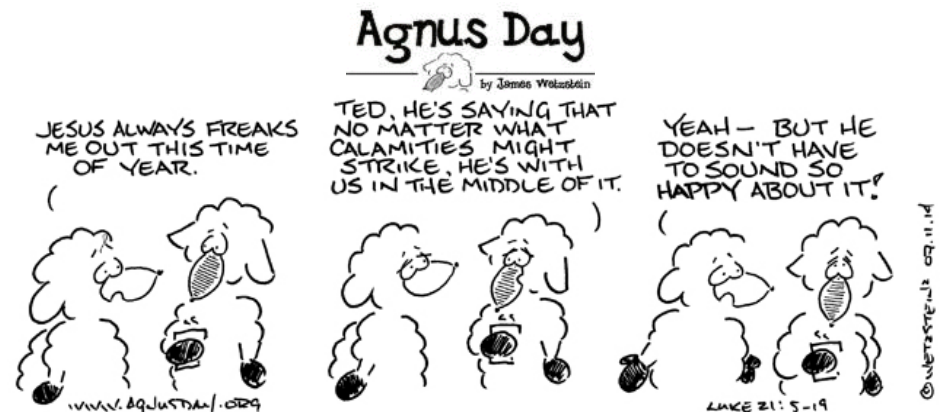
