Can you decipher what he really cries?






Second Sunday in Advent

December 4, 2022

Today's lessons:

- Isaiah 11:1–10 The prophet compares the coming Messiah to a new green shoot from a dead stump. He will be the true heir of King David (Jesse was David's father) and his rule will be just and wise.
- Psalms 72:1–7, 18–19 This psalm asks God to give the king wisdom so that the people have a good life.
- Romans 15:4–13 The Apostle Paul reminds his readers to be kind and welcoming to one another, no matter whether the other comes from a Jewish or a Gentile background. Because in Christ is fulfilled what the prophets predicted: the Gentiles worship God together with the Jews.
- Matthew 3:1–12 John the Baptist calls the people to repentance. He makes it urgent: Jesus the Messiah is already on his way.


