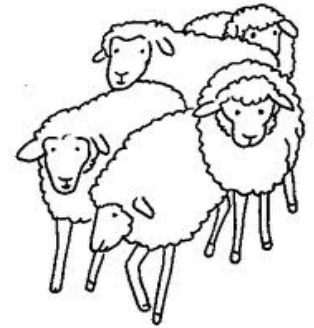

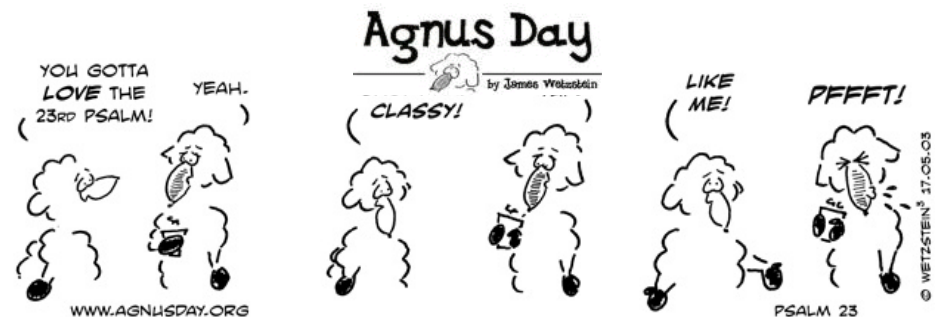


Fourth Sunday of Easter

Today's lessons:

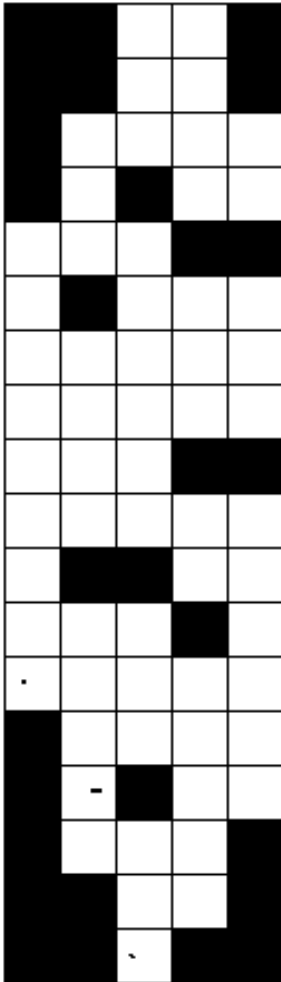
- Acts 2:42-47 After a great start on Pentecost Day, the life of the Church develops around the teachings of the apostles and the breaking of the bread, meaning the Gospel and Holy Communion or, as we now often say, Word and Sacrament.
- Psalms 23 The relationship between God and his people is like that between a shepherd and his sheep.
- 1 Peter 2:19-25 Following in Jesus' footsteps does not mean that life will be easy and successful. On the contrary: just as Jesus suffered for what he taught and did, those who follow him must be ready to suffer injustice, while themselves striving for righteousness.
- John 10:1-10 Jesus makes it clear that there is no way around him: he is the gate to the sheepfold. So whoever wants to be a leader in the Church, has to come through that gate, and accept that only Jesus Christ is the Good Shepherd. If they don't, they are nothing but thieves!



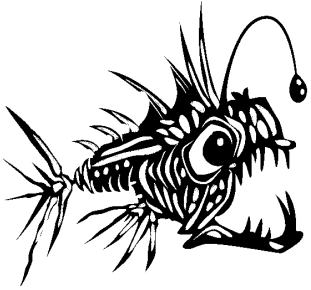

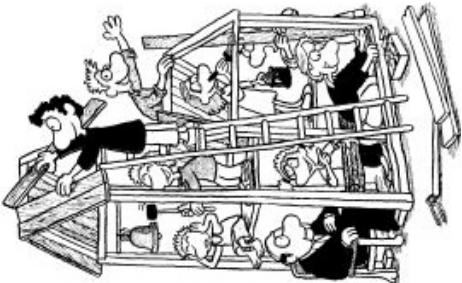
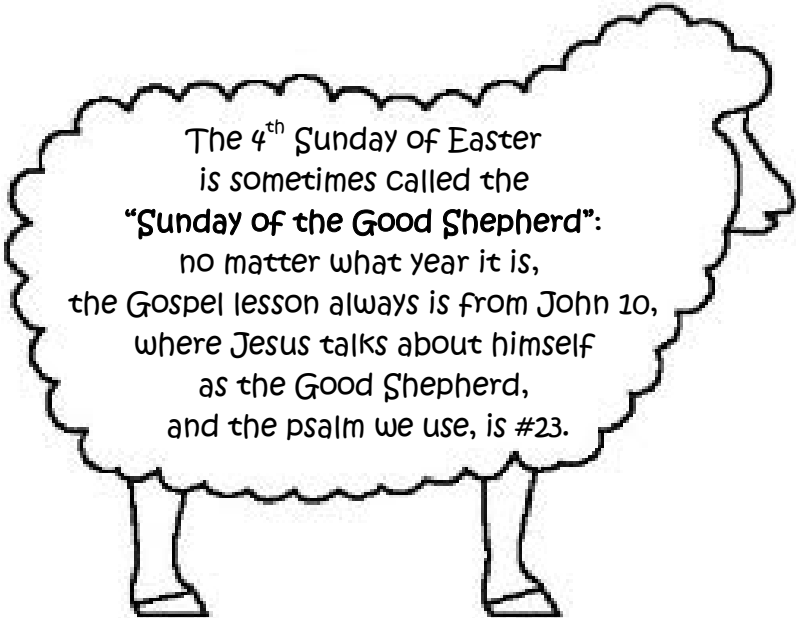
