

Genesis 1:1-2:4a In the beginning the Triune God created the world:

the Father the Word (= the Son, conf. John 1:1) and the Spirit of God hovered over the waters.

Psalm 8 God is praised for his creation.

2 Corinthians 13:11-13 Paul concludes his letter with the wish that the

Holy Trinity may be with the Christians in Corinth.

Matthew 28:16-20 At the end of the Gospel of Matthew Jesus sends

out his disciples on the mission to baptize people all over the world in the name of the Father and of

the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

### FOOL HANDS TRINITY PHRASE.


Well, that sounds foolish, indeed!


