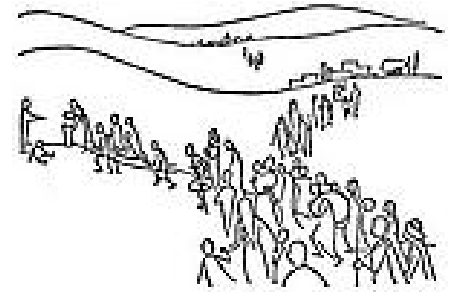

Matthew 9:35—10:8 (9-23) When Jesus sees the number of people who need his help he sends out his disciples as his authorised representatives, to multiply his ministry.

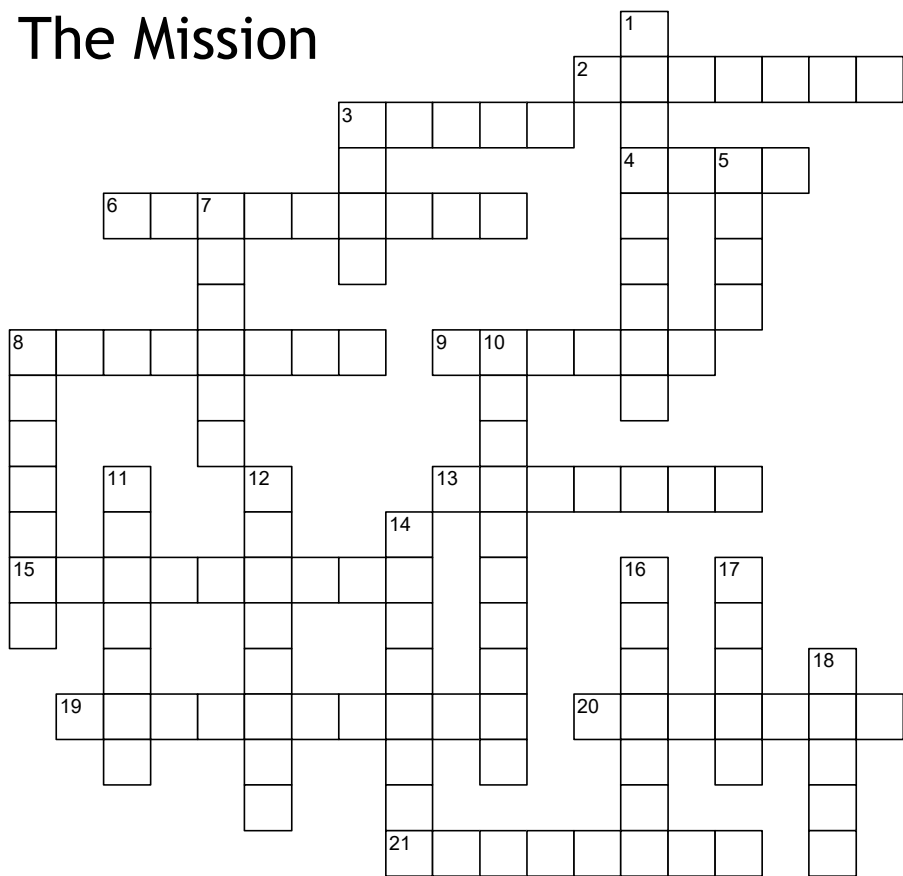
