Find the words from today's gospel and the first 16 of the remaining letters tell you what John says about himself.



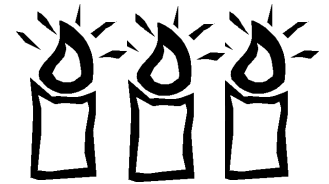

- John 1:6-8, 19-28 John's Gospel does not tell a Christmas story, but starts with John the Baptist who tells everybody about the coming Messiah who is the light of the world.
